

Giving Options

1) Place cash or check in the offering plate.

2) Text the amount you want to give to: 781-381-4488

Text "20 plate" to 781-381-4488 to give \$20, "5 plate" to give \$5, etc.

Text "[amount] pledge" to give towards your 2023-24 pledge (e.g. "100 pledge").

Text "[amount] project" to donate to UUCM's Sponsor-a-Project program.

Note: The first time you use text-to-give, you will receive a text message with a link that you will need to click, to enter your payment information.
